

Meadowdale Jamboree Check In

All teams must check in before entering their field area. It should be one representative only.

For the 12U teams there will be a table and tent by the parking lot by field 1 and 2.

A check in area will also be set up near the building for fields 3/4/5 for 14U.

I will need a parent signed roster and a copy of your insurance certificate regardless of the association. Beyond those girls in uniform you will receive badges with lanyard for the balance of your teams 25 for that session (for example you have 14 players you will be given 11 lanyards). The lanyards and badges are to be turned in at the end of your second game. A new badge will be given out on Sunday. Staff will be monitoring the fields and asking those without lanyards to move on from the area. The bleachers will be part of the bench area for players and coaches so socially distanced there will not be much room for spectators. I don't anticipate that the concession stand will be open. The bathrooms will have a two person limit. I have arranged for Honey Buckets for field 1 and 2.

Balls: Utilize a system where the defense is responsible for the softballs during their time in the field. Teams will be allowed to use disinfectant on the balls. EACH TEAM will be given 4 Softballs for THEIR TEAM to use on defense during the event. If they go foul, their team is responsible for them. Balls will not need to be returned after the game, the team keeps them for ALL games and then takes them home.

It is important that we follow the all protocols.

Masks required for all athletes/participants. Coaches, trainers, managers, spotters, and any other paid or volunteer staff must wear face coverings at all times.

Physical distance of 6 feet must be maintained between staff, volunteers, and any spectators at all times with exceptions for training and medical personnel and volunteers performing their medical duties. Six feet of distance must be maintained among athletes when not engaged in sporting activities, huddles and team meetings must be physically distanced.

Teams are responsible for and required to maintain - manage their own Social Distancing - INCLUDING PARKING LOTS or team areas. Teams are responsible to monitor the number of spectators allowed for their own team.

NO Hand Shakes or High Fives - PRE or POST GAME and NO Huddles on or off the field

Teams need to bring their own - first aid kits - ice packs - hand sanitizer - disinfectant wipes.

Team is required to clean out dugouts of all items after each game.

Reminder - no seeds, no chew, and no spitting. Per CDC Guidelines

Dugouts - Social distancing will be instituted - limited # will be allowed in the dugout, but plan will be determined by the park layout. Base coaches & on deck batter is allowed on field. No additional players will be allowed to be in the field of play due to social distancing.

Let's all do our part to follow all the rules so our fastpitch teams can enjoy being back on the field,
